

ORDINANCE # 2014-01

7.30 (1) * Ordinance establishing split shifts for election officials.

STATE OF WISCONSIN

Town of Morrison, Brown County

Whereas the Town Board of the Town of Morrison, Brown County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s. 7.30 (1), Wis. stats., to adopt this ordinance.

Whereas this ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the selection of 2 [or more] sets of officials to work at different times on each election day as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Town Board of Morrison, Brown County Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:


There shall be split shifts for election workers on all election days. Such shifts shall be determined by the Clerk as necessary to meet election worker schedules and election day demands.


The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s. 60.80, Wis. stats.


