

TOWN OF MORRISON, BROWN COUNTY

April 11, 2017

The regular monthly meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Morrison was called to order by Chairman Tom Kempen, at 7:30 p.m.; Those attending, Kempen, Supervisors Dennis Laabs & Jenny Wasmuth, Clerk, Colleen Magley, Treasurer, Laurie Daul, Zoning Administrator Joy Koomen, Constable, William Lasee, Assessor Mike Denor, & 12 residents/observers;

Notice to all, Video Recording is taking place; Pledge to the flag;

Moved by Kempen, 2nd by Wasmuth to approve the agenda as presented;

Moved by Wasmuth 2nd by Laabs to approve the town board meeting minutes from March 16, 2017 minutes, m/c unanimously;

Treasurers Report, attached;

Zoning Administrators Report, attached, Plan Bd is working on the Code of Ordinances; Paul Van Dreel is violating our junk vehicle ordinance, a letter has been sent to him; Brown County is doing Aerial mapping, this is used & very beneficial for Zoning;

Constable Report -2 different dog calls;

Assessors Report, Denor uses the Aerial mapping every day and would encourage the town board to support this; comment on the junk vehicle ordinance, also encouraged the board to consider employing a code enforcer again; Open Book will be held May 11; Board of Review will be held May 23, Wi State Statutes allow the assessor to go on property once a year without owner's permission;

Open forum for comments, none;

Discuss/act on payment of bills, after further discussion, moved by Laabs 2nd by Kempen, to pay the voucher presented for \$ 25,307.47 m/c unanimously;

Discuss/act on the planned expansion of Wayside Rd to 36 feet and future snow removal versus merely plowing it off. There is a current town ordinance, Chapter 16, ban on parking on town roads for snow removal Nov 1-April 2 from the hours of 3 a.m.-8 a.m. Moved by Laabs, 2nd by Kempen to suspend the rules, discussion followed; North East Asphalt has been awarded the bid for the Wayside Road repairs; there is a camper in the right of way that may need to be moved; moved by Kempen to go back to regular session, 2nd by Laabs, m/c unanimously; Wasmuth would like to see the Planning Commission look at the ordinance for overnight parking on town roads;


Discuss/act on road repairs for 2017, SCOTT Construction will be chip sealing roads; after further discussion, moved by Laabs, 2nd by Wasmuth to chip seal road bid # 1, 3, 5, 6, 7, 8, gravel Driveways on Boeder Drive, Denor Drive, Klug Lane, Paul's Lane and Roffers Lane, & check on guard rails for Wayside Rd by the 3 tunnels, m/c unanimously;

Discuss/act on Temporary beer permit for WayMor Youth Sports June 2-4, 2017, moved by Wasmuth, 2nd by Kempen to approve this temporary beer permit, m/c unanimously;

Lemke Lane-gravel on lawns from winter plowing, moved by Kempen, 2nd by Laabs to suspend the rules; the road does not seem to be seal coated correctly, most stones ended up on resident's lawns; a double layer was requested but there is not enough traffic to pack it down; Lemke Lane and the River Rd repairs need to be reviewed by SCOTT Construction, it was a poor job; moved by Laabs to go back into regular session, 2nd by Kempen, m/c no further action;

Update on recycle center, set date to meet with Glenmore- May 2 at 8:00 p.m.
Discuss/act on storage for signs at recycle center- signs are held at several different places in the town; there is a need for a shelter to hold all town signs; Laabs brought quotes for storage containers; after further discussion, moved by Kempen to purchase a storage container for \$ 1,850.00 to hold the town signs, 2nd by Wasmuth, m/c unanimously; moved by Wasmuth, 2nd by Laabs to approve a check for \$ 1,850.00 for a storage container, m/c unanimously; Board members report, clerk report, general community news shared by board members; board suggestions for a matter for next month's meeting; need to look at bidding for deep ditch cutting this fall; complaint received about the plastics site; Mike Shenian replaced a culvert on Mill Rd; there are aluminized culverts ordered for Wayside Road, Pauls Lane, and Denor Drive; a tree was on a wire on Man Cal Rd, Shenian repaired; received a letter from ISO, 5 mile radius from the Wayside Fire House is classified at a 6; thanks to Ben Rosenbaum and the Wayside Fire Department volunteers for their accomplishments for better fire protection; Moved by Kempen, 2nd by Laabs to adjourn, m/c unanimously, meeting adjourned at 9:20 p.m.
