

TOWN OF MORRISON, BROWN COUNTY-


June 7, 2016

The regular monthly meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Morrison was called to order by Chairman Tom Kempen, at 7:30 p.m. The agenda was posted June 4, 2016; Present- Chairman Kempen, Supervisors, Dennis Laabs & Jenny Wasmuth, Clerk Colleen Magley, Treasurer, Laurie Daul, and 2 registered residents/observers; Zoning Administrator Joy Koomen, Constable Herald Treichel and Assessor Mike Denor were excused; Pledge to the flag; Announcement-Video recorder is running; Moved by Kempen, 2nd by Wasmuth to approve the modified agenda, removing the assessors report, m/c unanimously; Moved by Laabs, 2nd by Wasmuth to approve the May 29, 2016 town board meeting & May 19, 2016 Board of Review, m/c unanimously; Constable report-excused; Treasurers report attached; Zoning Administrator excused; Open forum for comments, none
Discuss/act on payment of bills, discussion followed, moved by Laabs, 2nd by Kempen to pay the voucher presented for a total of \$ 24,558.76, paying Marty Johnson for only building inspection, not for his subpoena charge, he was already paid from the Joint Municipal Court, m/c unanimously;
Discuss/act on Temp beer permit for Wayside Fire Dept Veterans Ride at Way-Morr Park, July 9, 2016, after further discussion, moved by Wasmuth, 2nd by Kempen to approve a temporary beer permit for the Veteran's Harley Ride July 9, 2016, m/c unanimously;
Discuss/act on Class B Intoxicating Liquor & Class B beer License applications received from The Coop, Wander Springs Golf Course, The Evergreen, Wayside Volunteer Fire Dept, Corner Hot Spot, DeGreef Ends Here, Trout Springs Winery & The Trading Post, after further discussion, moved by Kempen, 2nd by Laabs to approve the Class B beer and Class B liquor license to the Trade names of the applicants, only after all their required paperwork is completed; m/c unanimously;
Discuss/act on Cigarette License applications received from The Coop & Corner Hot Spot, after further discussion, moved by Laabs, 2nd by Wasmuth to approve the cigarette license as applied for, m/c unanimously; Discuss/act on 7 Operator License applications received, all background checks complete, moved by Kempen, 2nd by Laabs to approve all 7 operators license, m/c unanimously;
Discuss/act on Emergency plan for the Town of Morrison, the board would like some additional changes, this will be returned to the committee and on the July agenda; Discuss/act on repair of asphalt at the Town Hall discussion followed, moved by Laabs 2nd by Wasmuth to seek bids for hot mix for the Town hall parking lot, m/c, unanimously;
Discussion followed on repair of asphalt on Cooperstown road at Glenmore road over the new culvert, and asphalt on Man-Cal Road near Holly-Morr Road;
Discuss/act on engineering proposals for Wayside Road, more information is needed, this will be brought to the July meeting;
Discuss/act on tables/chairs for the town hall, after further discussion, moved by Wasmuth, 2nd by Laabs to purchase 1 caddy for the chairs, m/c unanimously;
Board members report, Laabs rented a tractor for the town ditch cutting, Kelly Collins and Perry Treichel will be cutting the ditches; Rick Magley will spray the guard rails; Morrison had 2 court cases held at the Joint Municipal court, both parties deemed guilty, they will be offered a payment plan, if no payments are made then there will be a warrent for their arrest; Moved by Kempen, 2nd by Wasmuth to adjourn, meeting adjourned at 9:57 p.m. m/c unanimously;
