

AMENDMENT TO THE ORDINANCE TO CREATE SECTION 06-03 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE TOWN OF MORRISON TO INCREASE THE TERM OF THE BROWN COUNTY JOINT MUNICIPAL COURT JUDGE PURSUANT TO ss 755.02 OF THE WISCONSIN STATUTES

THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF MORRISON, HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

The Town Board of the Town of Morrison has determined that the current Municipal Code shall be amended to increase the term of the Brown County Joint Municipal Court Judge from Two (2) years to four (4) years.

Accordingly, effective upon the commencement of the next term of the Municipal Court Judge on May 1, 2009, the Ordinance to Create Section 06-03 of the Municipal Code of the Town of Morrison to Create a Joint Municipal Court Per ss 66.0301 shall be amended so that Section 1, subsection 2 of the Ordinance, which is entitled "Elections" shall be struck in its entirety and replaced with the following:

2) Elections

Term: The Municipal Judge shall be elected at large in the spring election in odd-numbered years for a term of four (4) years commencing on May 1. All candidates for the position of Municipal judge shall be nominated by nomination papers as provided in ss 8.10, Wis. Stats, and selection at a primary election if such is held as provided in ss 8.11, Wis. Stats. The State elections board shall serve as filing officer for the candidates.

Electors: Electors in all municipalities that are parties to the agreement shall vote for judge.

With the exception of Section 1, subsection 2 entitled "Elections," the remainder of the Ordinance to Create Section 06-03 of the Municipal Code of the Town of Morrison to Create a Joint Municipal Court Per ss 66.0301 of the Wisconsin Statutes shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
