

ORDINANCE NO. 83-<sup>2</sup>3 of the

TOWN OF MORRISON, BROWN COUNTY WISCONSIN

The Town Board of the Town of Morrison, Brown County, State of Wisconsin does ordain as follows;

1. That the following town roads may be used for snowmobile routes as provided for in Section 350.02 (2) 5 of the Wisconsin Statutes.
  - a.  $\frac{1}{4}$  mile on "wayside Road east of County Highway G, located in sections 27 and 34.
  - b. 1 mile on Town Line Road east of County Highway G, located in sections 35 and 36.
2. Roadways other than those designated above, shall not lawfully be used for snowmobiling, unless town board approves otherwise.
3. That the town shall mark the prescribed snowmobile routes in accordance with Section 350.13, Wisconsin Statutes and any acts amendatory thereto.
4. That no person shall operate a snowmobile over the designated snowmobile routes at a rate of speed that exceeds the maximum speed limit posted thereon.
5. That no person shall operate a snowmobile at a rate of speed that is unreasonable or improper, under the conditions, and having regard for the actual and potential hazards then existing or in any careless way so as to endanger the person or property of another or while under the influence of intoxicating liquor, fermented malt beverages or controlled substance.
6. The operation of snowmobiles on any roadway in the town other than the prescribed routes is declared unlawful.

7. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, forfeit not less than ten dollars nor more than two hundred dollars for each offense, together with the costs of prosecution, and in default of payment of such forfeiture and costs, shall be imprisoned in the County jail until the same are paid, for a period of time not to exceed thirty (30) days.
8. If any section, clause, provision, or portion of this ordinance is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected thereby.
9. Any previous town ordinance or resolution in conflict herewith is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
10. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and publication.
