ORDINANCE NUMBER 00-2

An Ordinance of the Town of Morrison Requiring Inspection of Alcoholic Beverage Licenses for the Town of Morrison, Brown County, Wisconsin

The Town Board of the Town of Morrison, County of Brown, State of Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Inspections of New Alcoholic Beverage Licenses Required.

1. No alcoholic beverage license shall be issued for any premise unless such premises comply with and conform to all ordinances, health, sanitation, building, and fire regulation of the Town of Morrison and of the State of Wisconsin.
2. No alcoholic beverage license shall be issued for any premises unless the Chief of the Fire Department and the Director of Public Health, or their designees and unless such officers have filed with the Town Board a written report stating that said premises comply with foregoing paragraph.
3. Each licensed premises shall be maintained and conducted in a sanitary manner and shall be a safe and proper place for the purpose for which used.

SECTION 2. Applications for Intoxicating Liquor and Fermented Malt Licenses

1. Any material omission or materially inaccurate statement on the license application is grounds for denial.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication.
