


Ordinance to Ban Overnight Parking on Town Roads 2020-01


WHEREAS, any trailer, camper or other property capable of being towed, or any motor vehicle parked overnight on Town Roads can be a burden for such items as snow removal or other public purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Town Board of the Town of Morrison, Brown County, Wisconsin, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS;

1. No vehicle shall park in the road right of way of Town Roads from the hours of 3:00 AM until 8:00 AM.
2. Exceptions:
 - a. No exception shall be granted for longer than three consecutive days and no more than 15 total days of exceptions annually shall be granted by the Town Clerk to any one address within the Town, unless the Town Board determines that a 'good cause' continues to exist through no fault of the resident. 'Good cause' includes; driveway construction or maintenance, overnight houseguests, or owner/passenger medical conditions.
3. No exception shall supersede any snow emergency declared.
4. Penalty: Vehicles found parked in the road right of way will be towed. The cost of towing and all other associated charges shall be charged to the owner of such vehicle.
5. Effective Date. This ordinance will take effect upon adoption by the Town Board of the Town of Morrison
