

TOWN OF MORRISON RESIDENTS

Due to COVID-19, Early/Absentee voting is strongly encouraged

To allow for Social Distancing we will be having in-person absentee voting October 20- 3:00-7:00, October 22 - 8:00-10:00 a.m. & October 29- 1:30-4:00

Or Call 920-864-2388 or 920-864-3495 for an appointment

You MUST be registered to vote in the Town of Morrison. To register in-person bring proof you are a Town of Morrison resident. ex: utility bill, tax bill, paycheck stub, bank statement, driver's license with your Morrison address.

A copy of your valid, current Photo ID is required with your Absentee request. You may stop at the office to make a copy or take a picture with your smart phone and email to morrisontownhall@gmail.com

You may register to vote or request an absentee ballot online at www.myvote.wi.gov or print the forms from the website at www.townofmorrison.org Forms are also available in the blue box outside the town hall-return them to the clerk as soon as possible.

The deadline for requesting an absentee ballot is 4pm October 29

You may put your voted ballot in the Brown security box outside the town hall office door or drop off at the drive-thru booth outside the town hall on election day

TOWN OF MORRISON RESIDENTS CURBSIDE VOTING

The Town of Morrison will have curbside voting available for election on November 3, 2020, to protect the health of voters and election workers at the polling location.

Like everywhere else, the Town of Morrison faces some challenges as the COVID-19 pandemic plays out. Even in the midst of this, our democracy must go forward. That means conducting our election as safely as possible on November 3, 2020.

Residents that are not having any issues, may go in the polling place like always, following all guidelines that are asked of you.

State law allows for voters who are unable to enter their polling place on election day, to cast a ballot “curbside” with the assistance of 2 poll workers. If you are unable to enter the polling place because you are immunocompromised, show symptoms of COVID-19, are waiting for COVID-19 test results, or have a disability, please use this service.

Our procedure for curbside voting, for those needing this service will be as follows.

- *Bring along a hard surface to write on such as a clipboard
- *Enter townhall from COUNTY HIGHWAY G
- *Pull up to our new drive-thru building (signage will help direct you)
- *Have your ID ready to show. (Poll workers will not handle your ID)
- *Pens will be provided, but if you are more comfortable, bring your own. Black ink.
- *You will not be expected to sign the poll book, EXEMPT will be written by your name.
- *Two poll workers will walk you through the process and your ballot will be put in a security sleeve.
- *Your ballot will be immediately taken into the hall, your name/addressed announced, the ballot will be fed directly into the machine. The inspector will come out and signal you can leave when it is accepted.
- *You will exit the drive-thru on Park Road (Highway Z)

Thank-You all for your cooperation and making the Town of Morrison a safe place to vote.
